Special offers for international PhD students and postdocs

International PhD students and postdocs additionally profit from a service-oriented concept of support, funded by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) within the framework of its STIBET program, including

- short-term grants and other funding (e.g. teaching and research assistantships)
- weekly office hours for international doctoral students
- peer-to-peer coaching by other PhD students
- a "Welcome Night" at the beginning of each semester
- cultural activities pertaining to discovering Germany, excursions and leisure activities
- support program for doctoral researchers with child(ren)
